The Dickens Universe has been in existence for nearly forty years. Part scholarly meeting and part public humanities project, it is the main event produced each year by a scholarly consortium called The Dickens Project, which promotes the interdisciplinary study of Victorian culture. It began as a multi-unit research project within the UC system, but now includes participating universities, such as Stanford, USC, Rice, Vanderbilt, Hebrew University of Jerusalem, University of Iowa, Indiana University, University of South Carolina, Rutgers, Yale, NYU, CUNY, Indiana, Cornell, Columbia, and Exeter. And now for the second year, the University of Haifa.
